- NAME: HARLEM FANS CLUB – RUTH EVANS MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP
- OFFERED BY: HARLEM FANS CLUB, INC.
- DESCRIPTION: An annual (non-renewable) award provided by the Harlem Fans Club to graduating Harlem High School Seniors wishing to further their education by attending an accredited college, junior college, or university (public or private).
- RESTRICTIONS: Available only to graduating Harlem High School Seniors. Not awarded to students attending trade or vocational schools.
- FIELD Any chosen field leading to an associate and/or bachelor degree.
- VALUE OF AWARD: **TWO - \$1,000** scholarships awarded annually: **\$1,000 to a qualified male student and \$1,000 to a qualified female student.**
- ELIGIBILITY: A. Must be a Senior graduating from Harlem High School.
- B. Must have a 3.0 GPA
- C. Must be of good moral character.
- D. Must have been involved or supported athletics either as a participant or manager of an approved Harlem High School sport or as a member of a supportive group such as Spirit Squad or any athletic related group recognized by and under the jurisdiction of the Harlem High School Athletic Department.
- E. Must be a member of at least one other school approved club and/or organization.
- F. Must show over-all desire to be involved with and be part of Harlem High School related activities.
- BASIS OF AWARDS: Awards are granted on the basis on involvement, participation, leadership, satisfactory academic progress and good moral character. Application will also be judged on neatness, grammar and spelling.
- PROCEDURES: Scholarships to be issued in the winning students name to the school of their choice.
