MTSS - MULTI-TIERED SYSTEMS OF SUPPORT

Harlem School District utilizes a Multi-Tiered System of Supports (MTSS) that focuses on helping all children realize their unlimited potential. MTSS provides academic and social/emotional interventions and/or enrichment through tiers of support. MTSS is a structure for continuous improvement that is systematic, prevention-focused, and data-informed. All students receive Core (Tier 1) instruction. When a student needs additional support, they receive supplemental interventions (Tier 2) that increase in intensity (Tier 3) to match a student's needs. At times, students require enrichment to support their learning; this is also supplemental to core instruction.

What can I do at home to help my student?

Parents and Guardians play a very important role in supporting their children in school. Harlem invites all parents to participate in guiding their children toward academic excellence and the development of strong character.

Things Parents/Guardians can do:

- Talk with your child about their school day.
- Talk with your child's teachers and attend conferences.
- Attend activities and school functions with your child.
- Celebrate your child's successes.
- Create routines at home such as bedtimes, homework times, and helpful chores.
- Monitor your child's grades and attendance.
- Know your child's friends.
