#### **NEW POSITIONS**

##### **Special Education Teacher – Parker Center**

At Parker Center there is a need to add a 1.0 FTE Special Education teacher for a Kindergarten Self-Contained classroom. Currently there are 17 students that will require a self-contained special education classroom placement for Kindergarten starting FY 2018. Due to state regulations under Section 226.730 on class sizes limits for self-contained classrooms for special education there is a limit of one teacher to a maximum of 10 students for children aged 3-5 years old. As a result, we will need to add the additional teacher at Parker Center in order to accommodate the number of students needing a Kindergarten self-contained special education classroom.
