



# iPods

## Borrowing eAudio

### What you need:

- An iPod
- An iPod cable to plug into your computer
- [omnilibraries.org](http://omnilibraries.org)
- OverDrive Media Console for Windows or Mac
- Your library card number barcode number and PIN

### How it works:

#### Install software

To transfer MP3 or WMA audio files to your device, you will need to download the OverDrive Media Console (OMC) to your home computer from the [omnilibraries.org](http://omnilibraries.org) website. Note: Not all WMA audio titles are available to transfer to an iPod due to publisher agreements. A Windows computer is required to transfer WMA titles.

#### Prepare Device

From [omnilibraries.org](http://omnilibraries.org), click on Help, then OverDrive Help, then Get Started With iPod and follow instructions. Also be sure to enable 'Manually manage music' on your Apple device's settings.

#### Browse, check out, download

1. To get started, access the [omnilibraries.org](http://omnilibraries.org) website Help, then OverDrive Help, Get Started With iPod
2. Sign in with your library card barcode and PIN.
3. Check out and download an audiobook using your Windows or Mac computer.
4. Windows users can transfer MP3 and compatible WMA audiobooks to an iPod. Mac users can transfer MP3 audiobooks.
5. Transfer it to your device.

#### Enjoy !

Once you have transferred a title onto your iPod, you can open it up just like you would any audio file on the device. You will find WMA titles listed with your playlists. MP3 titles will be under 'Music'.
